

ECSL Program Information 2015

General Program Information

An intensive program is 25 classroom hours per week (at ECSL one hour = 60 minutes) and five hours of social activities per week. ECSL has four terms per year and each term lasts three months. The term start dates are the recommended start dates. However, students can start most Mondays. In each term students will complete one full level taken in two sessions with a midterm exam after the first session and a final exam at the end of term. ECSL offers six levels in total: Basics followed by Levels 100 through 500.

Classes are usually from 8:45am to 3:30pm Monday to Thursday and 8:45 am to 12:00 noon on Fridays.

University and College Pathway (UCP) with Bridging Level

For students who plan to attend one of ECSL's partner colleges or universities for vocational, undergraduate, and some post-graduate programs.

The UCP program is intensive and is designed as solid preparation for academic success. Students can start UCP in Level 200 allowing them plenty of time to master the skills they need for academic study. ECSL's UCP Level 500 is a 12-week bridging level and students who successfully complete this level gain direct entry to partner colleges and universities – no IELTS score required. ECSL has pathways to colleges and universities in Nova Scotia, PEI, Ontario, Saskatchewan, and the USA. Check our website for a full listing of institutions and their requirements. All of our partners provide Conditional Letters of Acceptance to both ECSL and the institution.

Masters Preparation (MP)

For students who wish to gain university preparation experience while studying to achieve a specific IELTS score for university Masters programs.

MP is a full-time program for students who require an exam score to attend a Masters program, or an English-speaking university that is not an ECSL partner. Students study IELTS + UCP which will provide both IELTS preparation and the university study-skills needed to succeed at an English-speaking university. Student can also start MP if they have an Academic IELTS score of 5.5. MP starts in Level 400.

International Business English Certificate and Diploma (IBEC and IBED)

For students who need professional English skills for their personal or professional life.

IBEC and IBED students learn English through a business focus. The Certificate (IBEC) program is 12 weeks (300 hours) and the Diploma (IBED) program is 24 weeks (600 hours). IBE starts in Level 300.

IELTS Preparation (IP)

For students who wish to improve their English and study for an IELTS exam.

IP is a full-time program for students who want to improve their English in Canada while also studying to take an IELTS exam at East Coast School of Languages IELTS Test Centre. IELTS students study general English skills and test-taking skills to achieve their required IELTS score. IELTS starts in Level 300.

English for Communication (EC)

For students who want to achieve fluency in speaking and listening skills.

EC, our General English program, is available for students of all levels. When students reach ECSL's Level 300, they can choose between *Dynamic Speaking*, where they improve speaking skills through role plays, debates, discussion and interviews, or *Creative English* where they have fun with English through four themes: English and Food, English and Art, English and Media, and English and Music. Each theme lasts for six weeks.

Teaching English to Young Learners (TEYL)

For international students who wish to achieve a certificate for teaching children overseas.

This four week (100-hour) program is offered several times a year. The program gives students the tools, the experience, and the edge to be competitive in the expanding market of teaching English to children. Check our website for available start dates. TEYL starts in Level 400.
